






Threading a Needle




Tying a Knot




Running Stitch

Used for patching a hole, applique, patchwork detail and to mark out the area when darning.





Back Stitch


A stronger stitch used for sewing torn seams back together, sewing up a hem and creating a simple joined up line in embroidery embellishment.




Sewing on a Patch










Sewing on a Button
